The Legal Issues Institute agenda covers issues on zoning, subdivision, annexation, incompatible uses, non-conforming uses, conflict of interest, finding-of-fact, planning commission/zoning administrator responsibilities, and other planning law issues at the municipal/county level.

Mr. Ptak's experiences include serving as a representative to the Norfolk Planning Commission while the City of Norfolk's city attorney and former Deputy Madison County Attorney, which led him to become one of the foremost educators' in the practical and legal application of land use planning law in Nebraska. Mr. Ptak's role as an educator has continued while serving as legal counsel staff for the Northeast Community College, Norfolk Nebraska. Mr. Ptak is in the forefront as an educator/trainer for the statewide associations of the Nebraska Planning Association and the Nebraska Chapter of the American Planning Association. There are few Nebraska natives that have unselfishly dedicated their skills and knowledge base in the delivery of a comprehensive ethical approach for educating local municipal and county planning officials. Mr. Ptak has presented several institutes and workshop sessions throughout the past twenty years in support of land use planning law in Nebraska.
